Dear library supporters,

In FY23, the Albany County Public Library Foundation was able to support your public library with more than \$93,000! We could not provide this incredible level of funding without your generous support. It is with deep gratitude that we thank you for continuing to support Albany County Public Library.

The ACPL Foundation Board of Directors and its staff are appreciative of the partnership with all of our supporters resulting in a \$60,000 annual disbursement to ACPL. This \$60,000 went to support all ages programming, materials, the bookmobile, travel, and continuing education for staff. Additional funding supported a mini-grant project, library outreach, special projects, designated purposes, and staff longevity.

Beyond financial support, ACPL Foundation staff provided time to library projects in FY23 by working on the bookmobile project, managing grant projects with library staff, and hosting outreach events.

Here are a few FY23 highlights:

- Used funding from the Sally Dieterich Restricted Fund to host author and National Book Award Finalist, Kali Fajardo-Anstine.
- Partnered with Leadership Laramie on a beautification project to update the StoryWalk® around the exterior of the Laramie branch.
- Received \$43,750 in grant funding from the Guthrie Family Foundation, the Wyoming Community Foundation, the Rocky Mountain Power Foundation, the First Interstate Bancsystem Foundation, and the Socrates Foundation.
- Raised a record amount selling 142 packages with our Blind Date with a Book fundraiser and started hosting
 in-person fundraising and outreach events again, following a few years with no in-person events due to the
 pandemic.
- Collaborated with ACPL and the Wyoming Humanities Council on the Young Writers Program.

These essential projects and areas of support were fully funded with your help, allow the library to offer learning opportunities, access to check out items, more outreach across Albany County, and a well-prepared and welcoming staff.

You may remember that in the previous fiscal year, the ACPL Foundation was able to provide around \$10,000 more to support ACPL. This is because inflation started to have a greater impact on our donors in FY23 and the investment market took several hits. While the ACPL Foundation didn't meet its goal for individual giving in FY23, we are working to meet and engage with new donors in order to increase our support for ACPL.

In FY24, the ACPL Foundation plans to continue supporting ACPL with its entire programming budget and nearly half of its budget for materials, as well as funding other areas. We know that these goals are only possible because of your generosity.

Opportunity happens at ACPL when you donate. Thank you for being part of our community of library supporters!




FY23 Financial Summary



Contribute to an ACPL Foundation Restricted Fund:

Each restricted fund was created to honor an individual or family. On a fiscal year basis, a portion of each fund provides the library with funding for specific programs or materials.

Colleen Asplund Fund: Asplund was a former ACPL children's librarian. Interest from this fund is used for children's materials in the library.

John Burman Fund: Burman was the longtime chair of the ACPL Foundation board, served on the library board, and was a significant library supporter. The fund is used for general purposes.

Barbara Chatton Fund: Chatton is a longtime supporter, volunteer, and ACPL Foundation board member. Interest from this fund goes to the library for its children and young adult collections.

Gwendolyn Cook Fund: Cook was a former head of library circulation. Interest from this fund is used to purchase cookbooks, Regency Romance, and mystery books for the library.

Sally Dieterich Fund: Dieterich was a longtime library patron and supporter. The fund is used for library programming.

Friends of the Book Sale Fund: This fund was set up to honor the work of the Friends of the Library Book Sale Crew. Interest from the fund is used to buy adult fiction materials.

Love Family Fund: J. David and Jane Love were longtime library supporters. This fund is used for the ACPL Foundation minigrant program.

Neva Miller Fund: Miller was a former ACPL children's librarian. Interest from this fund is used for children's materials in the library.

Agnes Milstead Fund: Milstead was a former ACPL Foundation board member and library advocate. Interest from this fund is used for the ACPL Foundation mini-grant program.

Mary Lou Pence Fund: Pence was a local author. Interest from the fund supports the library's Wyoming Room. The Wyoming Room houses local and state historical documents, books and information.

Adele Russin Fund: Russin was a longtime library supporter and former library board member. Interest and half of the fund's annual contributions benefit the library's Large Print books, audiobooks, and Play-A-Ways.

Susan Simpson Fund: Simpson served as the ACPL county librarian and continues to support the public library. Interest from this fund is used for staff training and development opportunities.
